This Test has a Licensing outcome

To be eligible to qualify for a rigid vehicle (GVM over 4.5 tonne) driver licensing outcome, you must:

1. Reside in the NT
2. Have held a 'C' class driver licence for not less than 12 months (LR/MR) or 24 months (HR)
3. Have passed the MVR theory test
4. Your licence must be NT issued

Test Information

This test is conducted in the following format (all times are minimums):

1. Section A: 15 minute pre-drive (Pre-Operational Checks and Cabin Drill)
2. Section B: 90 minute Vehicle Operation and Control (the 'On Road' Component)
3. Section C: Low Risk Driving Behaviours (the 'continuous assessments')
4. Section D: Compliance (the 'one off' assessments)
5. Section E: 10 minute Additional Risk Management (Reverse, Hill Stop/Start, Load Securing, Bus Stop Procedure (bus only))

The test will be conducted using one of NATA's MVR approved test routes. All required Test materials are supplied by MVR, and issued by NATA with MVR approval.

MVR Theory Test

This test is conducted by MVR and prospective licence applicants should first visit <https://nt.gov.au/driving/heavy/heavy-vehicle-theory-test> for a step by step guide.

Driving Test

The cost for driving test is:

LR \$300.00, plus GST \$30.00

MR \$400.00, plus GST \$40.00

HR \$500.00, plus GST \$50.00

You can book times for your test with the NATA office. Remember, CT is a **test only** pathway to obtaining your licence upgrade. No coaching, training or tutoring from your Driving Examiner is allowed under MVR guidelines.

Assessment Criteria

Successful completion of the CT requires all applicants to **pass ALL criteria** as listed. Some errors are permitted:

Section A: No more than **2 errors** (except seatbelt error, where the test is terminated)

Section B: No more than **4 errors**

Section C: No more than **2 errors**

Section D: **No errors**, all errors recorded against this section result in test termination

Section E: No more than **1 error**

You should note the following overall factors during the Test:

- Safety is not compromised
- Control is demonstrated at all times
- Impact on other road users
- Safely managing hazardous situations

On finishing your test, you will be issued with your Driving Examiner's test sheet where **PASS** or **FAIL** will be recorded.

If your result is a fail and/or test termination, you cannot continue to drive the vehicle, or book another time for CT on the same day.

If your result is a **FAIL**, your Driving Examiner will advise you of your options.

If your trainer and assessor believes you are fatigued, or have drugs or alcohol in your system, you will be asked to show cause why you should undertake/continue your test. You may be asked to reschedule, this may be at extra cost to you.

Licensing Information

To be issued with your licence, you will need to present your **test sheet** within **12 months** from date of issue to the NT Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR), phone **1300 654 628** for locations. MVR will charge **\$6.00** to upgrade your licence.

Payment

Payment of the quoted fee for the licence upgrade class is required on booking to confirm your test time.

Direct Deposit

Direct deposit payments may be made on-line or at any branch of the Westpac Bank.
