## Licence to Drive a Heavy Rigid Vehicle TLILIC2016

This course is for workers from transport, retail, wholesale, warehousing, etc, who require licensing under Motor Vehicle Legislation.

On completion of this course, you are eligible to apply for your NT issued driver licence to be upgraded to an HR driver licence (subject to MVR requirements).

NATA HR has a synchromesh gearbox your HR licence outcome will attract a 'b' condition. NATA can provide training and assessment to remove this condition. Please speak with your trainer about our program, or request our brochure '*Removal of x or b conditions*'.

This Course has a Licensing outcome

To be eligible to qualify for a heavy rigid vehicle driver licensing outcome, you must:

1. Reside in the NT
2. Have held a 'C' class driver licence for at least 24 months
3. Your licence must be converted to NT issue before it can be upgraded

### Course Information

This course is conducted in the following format:

1. a first day intake for a theory session and assessment
2. up to 7 hours (c upgrade), 6 hours (LR upgrade) or 5 hours (MR upgrade) of practical training is included, conducted in sessions as required and booked.
3. The Final Competency Test is conducted by a NATA Driving Examiner according to MVR rules. The Test's on-road component is 45 minutes following an MVR approved route.

The course will be delivered at NATA's course delivery site, or another suitable location, eg. as arranged with your employer. All required learning and assessment materials are supplied.

All practical training is one to one. Course intake numbers are limited to a maximum of 6 licence applicants.

## Course Details

The course is GST exempt (where eligible).  
Costs are:

- **\$1,300.00** (c class to HR)
- **\$1,200.00** (LR-HR)
- **\$1,000.00** (MR to HR)

NATA prefer to use their vehicle for training and assessment. Please contact our office for details if you have specific requirements which will require your vehicle to be used for training and assessment.

*For class HR, you **MUST** be able to drive a manual vehicle to have a realistic chance at passing the competency test.*

### Intake and Theory Test

**Start at 8am, finish by 12noon**

You will learn about the basics of vehicle control and operation, engine management, load restraint and fatigue management. The assessment is to be attempted before Intake, simply pick up your driver manual and assessment at the NATA office.

*Note: When driving an HR class heavy vehicle you must be **drug and alcohol free**. If your trainer and assessor believes you are **fatigued**, or have drugs or alcohol in your system you will be asked to show cause why you should continue your lesson. You may be asked to reschedule, this may be at extra cost to you.*

## Practical Training

Your course fee includes up to **7 (c-HR), 6 (LR-HR) or 5 (MR-HR) hours** of practical training. You can book times for practical training with the NATA office or with your trainer and assessor. Extra practical sessions may be booked for **\$165.00** per hour.

Please be aware that if a dangerous situation is caused by you, as a student whilst driving, our trainer may terminate your session and request you to reschedule, this may be at extra cost to you.

## Assessment Information

### Theory

You will answer 24 questions during your own time or at Intake, the test is open book.

### Practical

This assessment takes about 1 hour 15 mins and requires driving of a set route, and performing a set of tasks as required under MVR and unit of competency packaging rules.

Reassessment is conducted according to MVR requirements.

## Statement of Attainment

On achieving competency, you will be issued with a Statement of Attainment. You must provide, or allow NATA ability to create and/or search for, your valid Unique Student Identifier (USI). For further information, see [www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au)

## Licensing Information

For your licence upgrade, you will need to present your MVR Test and Statement of Attainment within 12 months from date of issue to the NT Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR), phone **1300 654 628** for locations. MVR will charge **\$7.00** to upgrade your licence.

## Payment

Payment of **\$650.00** (c-HR), **\$600.00** (LR-HR), or **\$500.00** (MR-HR) is required before commencement of the course.

The balance is due and payable after your assessment. A **\$500.00** fee will apply where re-assessment is necessary.
